<u>Tender Notice of Main Contract Works for Columbarium Building and Garden of</u> Remembrance at Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery (Tender Reference: CW001/2024)

# **Description:**

The works include the Construction of the Columbarium Building and Garden of Remembrance at Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery (Excavation and Lateral Support, Site formation, Foundation, Superstructure & Fitting out works). The works are scheduled to commence tentatively in Q3 2024 and complete in Q1 2027.

- i) Contractor must be a Groups B or C Contractor included on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works under the Buildings Category as published by the Development Bureau of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and shall not be suspended from tendering for public works contracts at the time of the close of tender;
- ii) Contractor must be a Registered General Building Contractor with new built project experiences with single contract value of not less than \$200 million within the last 5 years; and
- iii) Contractor and/or their subcontractor must be a Registered Specialist Contractor in Site Formation Works ("RSCSF") with experience(s) in site formation works and excavation and lateral support works on sloping site with contract value of not less than \$20 million; and
- iv) Contractor and/or their subcontractor must be a Registered Electrical Contractor included on the List of Approved Contractors under Electrical and Mechanical Services Department.; and
- v) Contractor and/or their subcontractor must have non-domestic fitting out project experience with single contract value of not less than \$20 million within the last 5 years;
