For implementation of the Worshipping Mode, BMPC is inviting software developers in developing a WISE Worshipping and Memorial System which consists of two major parts, an online services platform and a venue management system.

Software developers meeting the following conditions are welcome to submit the tender:-

- (i) a software development company duly established in Hong Kong; and
- (ii) have not less than 10 years’ software development experience.
