**Tender Notice of Remedial Works for Feature No. 6SE-D/R131 (Section 8 Terrace 11 and Terrace 17) at Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery**  
**(Tender Reference: CS001/2025)**

**Description:**

The remedial works for Feature No. 6SE-D/R131 (Section 18 Terrace 11 and Terrace 17) at Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery include the construction of soil nails, mass concrete retaining walls and soldier pile walls in response to the landslip incident in April 2024. The Works are scheduled to commence in Q3 2025 and complete in Q2 2026.

Contractors who must be included on the list of Approved Specialist Contractors for Public Works in the Category of “Landslip Preventive/Remedial Works to Slopes/Retaining Walls” under the Development Bureau of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and shall not be suspended from tendering at the time of the close of tender and have past experience in providing similar scale of works with a contract sum not less than \$10 million in the past eight years.
