Tender Notice of Nominated Sub-Contract for Design, Supply and Installation of Lift for Columbarium Building (Tender Reference: CW001/2025)

Description:

The tender is for the design, supply and installation of lift at Columbarium Building at Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery. The works are scheduled to complete in Q1 2027.

- i. Contractor must be a **Registered Lift and Escalator Contractor** under Electrical and Mechanical Services Department Works;
- ii. Contractor must have experience in installation of lift and external / semi-open escalator over the past 5 years and of contract sum of **not less than \$6 million**; and
- iii. Contractor shall not be suspended from tendering by any Government Authority / Department at the time of the close of tender.

The tender offers should be deposited to BMCPC’s tender box situated at 34/F, Wu Chung House, 213 Queen’s Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong before closing date. Sealed tenders, in duplicate, must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer). Late tenders will not be accepted.

- a. If a black rainstorm warning signal or a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is in effect at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on the closing date, tenders closing time will be postponed to 12:00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered.
