Submission of Tenders:

Sealed tenders, in duplicate, must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to BMCPC Tender Box situated at 34/F, Wu Chung House, 213 Queen's Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong. Late tenders will not be accepted.

Remarks:

- a. If a black rainstorm warning signal or a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is in effect at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on 31 May 2019, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12:00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered.
- b. Open tendering is adopted. Contractors who meet the following qualifications and other conditions stipulated in the tender documents are invited to tender:-
 - (i) Contractor must be a Groups A, B or C contractor included on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works under the Buildings Category as published by the Development Bureau of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and shall not be suspended from tendering for public works contracts at the time of the close of tender. Contractors not yet on the above-mentioned approved list/category may also submit a tender if they meet the qualifications and conditions for participation and their application for inclusion in the above-mentioned approved list/category is duly approved by the Development Bureau on or before the tender closing date; and
 - (ii) Contractor shall have completed at least two (2) building works projects of contract value not less than \$30 million in Hong Kong in the past 8 years, counting from the original date set for the close of tender.
